TOTUS TUUS IS COMING TO OUR PARISH! What is Totus Tuus? Totus Tuus (totally yours) is a fun and energetic parish-based summer catechetical program for students from Kindergarten to high school. The program gathers college students and seminarians into 4-person teams and sends them to spread the Good News of the gospel to parishes through the diocese.

The team will arrive in Edina Saturday, July 22, and the program will run July 24-28. The program for K-6th grades will run 9:00-2:30, including Mass each day, and the program for 7-12th grades will run nightly from 7:30-9:30.

The program is open to local children/youth of all denominations, and we are also inviting children and youth from neighboring parishes. There is no cost to attend, but we will be asking children to pre-register to aid in meal planning and logistics.

We are excited to be able to offer this program, and we need the help of our parishioners to make it a success. Each evening of the program the Totus Tuus team will have supper with a different host family. There will also be a parish potluck dinner Thursday night, July 27th.
